APPROVED FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEMS

The following list is provided for clarification of “Approved Fire Protection Systems” as defined by Alaska Statute 18.70.081, and supersedes all previous memos regarding this matter.

- I. The following is a list of Approved Fire Protection Systems.
 - A. Water-based fire sprinkler systems, which provide complete coverage throughout the Structure, designed, installed, and maintained in accordance with the International Building Code as amended, the International Fire Code as amended, and NFPA # 13.
 - B. Water-based fire sprinkler systems (in residential occupancies up to and including four stories), which provide complete coverage throughout the structure, designed, installed, and maintained in accordance with the International Building Code as amended, the International Fire Code as amended, and NFPA #13R.
 - C. Water-based fire sprinklers systems (in one and two family dwellings and manufactured homes), which provide complete coverage throughout the structure, designed, installed, and maintained in accordance with the International Building Code as amended, the International Fire Code as amended, and NFPA #13D.
 - D. Water mist fire protection systems, which provide complete coverage throughout the structure, designed, installed and maintained in accordance with NFPA 750.
 - E. Halogenated fire extinguishing agent systems, which provides complete coverage Throughout the structure, Halon 1301 designed, installed and maintained in accordance with NFPA # 12 A.
 - F. All water-based fire protection systems listed above shall be maintained in accordance with NFPA # 25 and in accordance with 13 AAC 50.025.
