The BUS CODE OF CONDUCT

PLEASE DO:



- Pay your fare or show your pass every time you board
- Follow the driver's instructions
- Respect others
- Be reasonably clean
- Use headphones at a reasonable level
- Sit back and relax

PLEASE DON'T:



- Block the aisles
- Eat on the bus
- Smoke or use any form of tobacco
- Shout, swear or make inappropriate gestures
- Bring alcohol or drugs on the bus
- No weapons except where permitted by state law
- Litter on the bus or at the bus stop
- Disturb others

Follow the Code and Enjoy the Ride

The BUS wants to make sure all our passengers enjoy a safe and comfortable ride. To make sure this is possible, these specific activities are **NOT ALLOWED** on the bus and bus stops:

- Placing your feet on the seats or safety bars;
- Hanging or swinging off the safety bars/handles;
- Transporting animals, except in a secure container (only service animals are allowed without a container);
- Roller skating, in-line skating or skate boarding;
- Camping or storing personal property;
- Using transit properties for sleeping;
- Bringing odors which unreasonably disturb others on the bus;
- Spitting or using the bus when other bodily fluids such as blood are present;
- Putting anything out the window or attaching yourself to the bus exterior;
- Damaging or defacing the bus, bus stop or bus shelters;
- Throwing objects;
- Behaving in a way that offensive to others, using offensive language and/or gestures;
- Carrying any flammable material; or
- Interfering in any way with the operation of the bus.

Commercial activity such as distributing literature, posting leaflets or putting up signs on the buses or transit facilities (includes bus shelters) is prohibited. Displaying or offering goods for sale is not allowed except by written agreement with Ketchikan Gateway Borough Transit Department.

Break the Code and Lose Your Ride on The BUS

Passengers who break the Code or break the law while using The BUS will be dealt with immediately.

Criminal conduct is prohibited on all Ketchikan Gateway Borough properties. The Ketchikan Police Department or Alaska State Troopers will be called if problems occur.

In addition to civil or criminal penalties, violators of the Code of Conduct or other laws may be denied service, suspended from using any of the buses or both.

Immediate denial of service may be enforced by the bus driver, a Ketchikan police officer or any authorized Ketchikan Gateway Borough Transit employee.

Violations of the Code of Conduct may result in your loss of privileges to use the bus system for 30 days or more.
