I am also aware that if any statement within this affidavit is false, I may be prosecuted pursuant to Alaska Statute and Regulations.

- An Application for Title & Registration (Form 812)
- Certificate of Vehicle Inspection (Form 811)
- Copy of Notice sent,
- The completed return receipt or the notice returned as undeliverable, refused, or unclaimed(unopened)
- Fees

NOTE: The person named on form 825 must obtain a title in their name before selling the vehicle.
